1. **General Stuff:** Name, age, what are you currently up to?

2. **Skills:** Tell us about your most relevant experiences and abilities, especially with the following:

- repetitive, unsupervised tasks
- manual labor (shoveling, raking, weeding, mowing, carpentry, lifting 50+ lbs)
- working 8 hours per day, 6 days per week for 6 months
- event planning
- bartending
- chef or kitchen skills
- children's education
- cleaning, organizing, system building
- business analytics

3. **Social stuff:** Tell us about home life and upbringing! What are your favorite books? Do you have a spiritual or philosophical practice? Have you had a garden before? What do you often eat? Are you involved in politics or activism? Are you tidy or messy? Do you like animals? Favorite thing to do to relax, And anything else that's relevant. None of these answers influence your ability to get a job here, it just helps us understand your background more.

4. **Specialty Interests:** Do you have any special skills such as chalkboard lettering, drawing, hard cider making, playing an instrument, knitting, etc?
